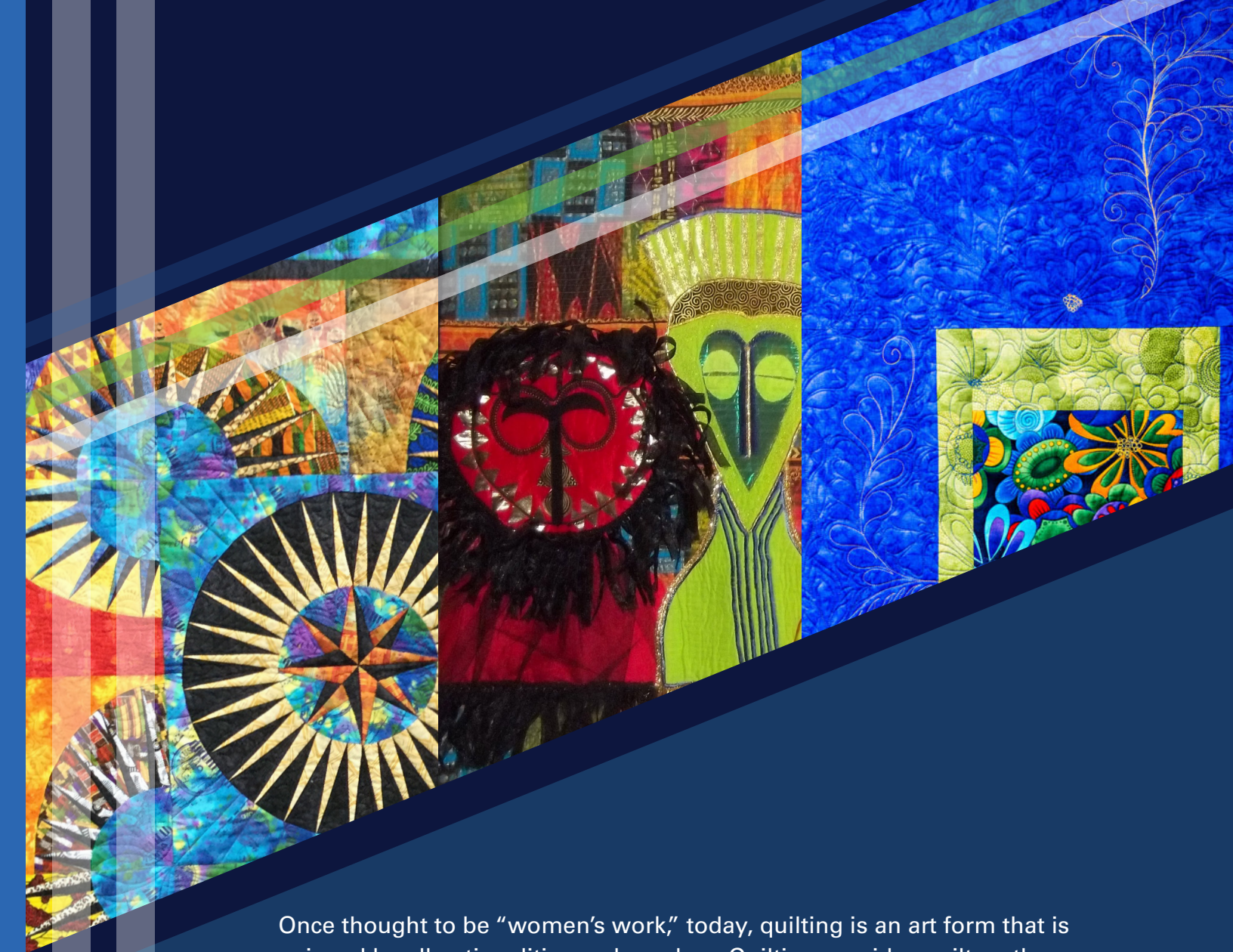
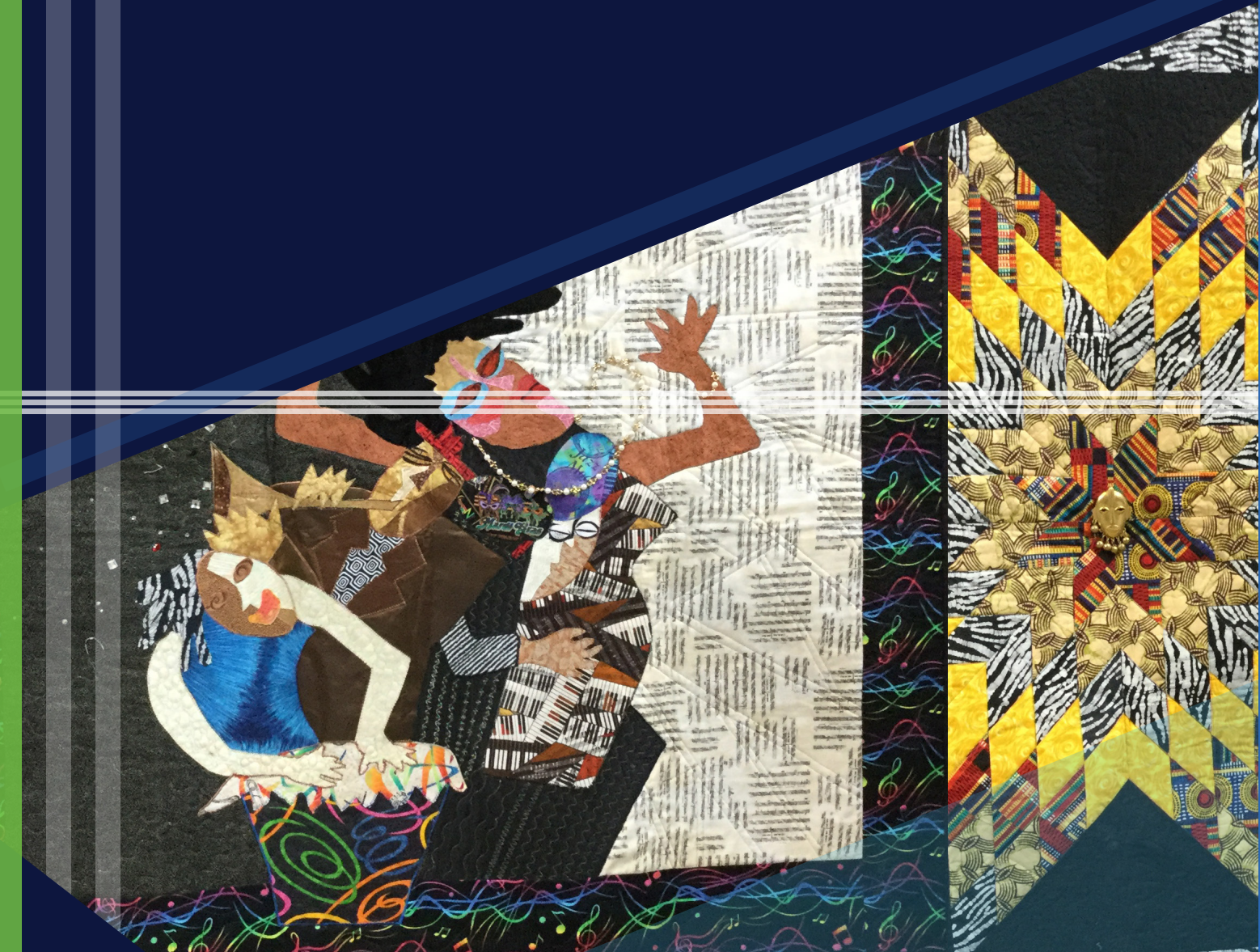




## CONNECTING THREADS
